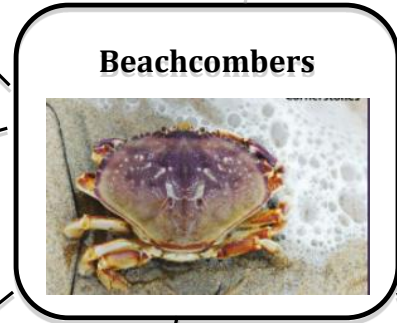




Key Stage 1 Homework Project Activities



Design, draw, and paint a picture of a beach hut. Bring it into class and display everyone's beach huts next to each other.

Make a 3-D sea animal. You could use any material you like – perhaps papier-mâché, fabric, plastic bottles, clay, play dough or Lego pieces?

Bring pictures from home of yourself or family members at the seaside or swimming in the sea.

Visit your local library to browse or borrow story and information books about the seaside. Write or film a book review about your favourite.

Make a word search with all the names of the living things you have learnt about. Ask your family and friends to have a go!

Make a miniature seashore garden, using natural materials such as pebbles, twigs, sand and shells.

Survey your friends and family to identify the 'Top Five Shore Activities' and show the results in a pictogram or bar chart.

Create a collage of a seaside scene using holiday brochures or magazines.
