

## English



Firstly, our daily English sessions will be focused around teeth and their functions. Through this learning children will develop a wider range of sentence types and statutory spellings. Our aim is to write an amazing fact file before going on to write a persuasive advert for a healthy sandwich. Towards the end of this half term, we will apply our knowledge of the digestive system to an explanation text through carefully planned paragraphs.



## Maths



**We will continue to develop knowledge of times tables especially focusing on accuracy and fluency. All children have a log in so that they can access TTRS at home.**

Over this half term children will also be developing their place value knowledge and applying this to different problems. The 4 rules will be a focus as children develop their strategies for answering calculations.

Through 'White Rose Maths' children will be involved in lots of practical activities to develop their knowledge of statistics, money, fractions and measures- length.

## Science

**Animals, including Humans.** Children will be introduced to the main body parts associated with the **digestive system**, for example, mouth, tongue, teeth, oesophagus, stomach and small and large intestine and explore questions that help them to understand their special functions. Children will work scientifically by: comparing the teeth of carnivores and herbivores, and suggesting reasons for differences: finding out what damages teeth and how to look after them. They will draw and discuss their ideas about the digestive system and be real scientists by conducting an experiment which will test out the process food goes through as it travels through the body.


## Topic

#### **Where did all the food go?**

Children will be learning all about the digestive system and through DT, children will learn all about healthy eating and different food groups.
